This Order Supplement is executed pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Department of Information Services (DIS), Customer Service Agreement. The parties acknowledge they have read and understand the terms and conditions contained therein. This Order Supplement sets forth provisions identifying Disaster Recovery services to be performed for the Washington State Lottery Commission (LOT). IT IS, THEREFORE, MUTUALLY AGREED THAT:

1. DESCRIPTION OF WORK TO BE PERFORMED:

DIS Data Network Services

The Department of Information Services, Data Network Services Section, will provide network disaster recovery services for the Systems Network Architecture (SNA) network if the System/370 processing and SNA network node site located at the OB#2 facility in Olympia become unavailable for an extended period of time.

This recovery will be accomplished for both remote circuits (circuits that utilize the DIS Digital Transport Service (DTS) connected to the remote node sites at Seattle, Spokane, Vancouver, and Yakima) and for local circuits that are terminated at the Lacey Node Site.

Circuits utilizing DTS will be 100 percent recovered. In the event of a disaster, the traffic will be routed from the closest DTS node site, through the Seattle Node Site, to the IBM Disaster Recovery "hot site" in Sterling Forest, NY.

DIS has provided a Lacey Node Site enabling LOT to divide its local leased private circuits between the Olympia Node Site and the Lacey Node Site. DIS recommends that LOT relocate a percentage of their circuits to the Lacey site. The actual percentage of circuits to be relocated will be dependent upon the agency's network design and business requirements. In the event of a disaster at OB#2, the circuits that terminate at the Lacey Node Site will be re-routed to the Sterling Forest "hot site." The recovery will be accomplished within 72 hours of a declared disaster.

Agency Network Services

The LOT Network Manager will be responsible for determining which circuits, if any, need to be relocated to the Lacey Node Site and with, the help of the DIS Data Network Services' technical staff, implement any necessary network changes.

LOT is responsible for providing all necessary interface equipment required to support circuits terminated at the Lacey Node Site.

2. **PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE:**

This agreement commences on July 1, 1994 and shall continue until terminated by mutual agreement between DIS and LOT as specified in the termination section of the DIS/LOT Interagency Agreement.

3. **COSTS:**

The disaster recovery charges are included in DTS and the SNA Front-End-Processor (FEP) monthly charges.

4. **AMENDMENTS:**

Should circumstances warrant, amendments to this Order Supplement shall be mutually agreed upon in writing. All such amendments shall take precedence over this Order Supplement.


